It looks just like a blink of an eye and 40 years have gone by ! and just as the poet who is fascinated by the blooming of the Daffodils and recalls them while passing through various moments and the moods of the life, we too are fascinated by what Hebron has emerged today.

With modest beginning of 20 students Hebron came into existence in June 1965 in a small building in Maninagar (east). With all sorts of misgivings and doubts e.g. whether Maninagar (east) will be able to absorb an English medium School; or not, where would we source our finances for future development and infrastructure, where would we get the teachers to teach the subjects in English medium, occupied our mind. But one cause was certain and that was we had the purpose and it is rightly said "*Find the purpose and the means will follow*".

We decided to form an Educational Trust and Hebron Education Trust came into existence with board member comprising of Late Simon Thakore, Smt. Dhirajben Thakore, Late Dr Cyril M Macwan, and Late J. Rajwadi. Advocate Mr. Ramesh Trivedi helped immensely to form

the constitution and register the trust.

We remember those moments when we made the announcement to start an English medium school and like all good idea we met with cynicism and opposition from many quarter. But God's plan are eternal and strong and cannot be overwhelmed by human beings nor can be thwarted by difficult times.

Hebron in midst of all this turbulence started emerging slowly but steadily and added each year new academic class, despite the fact that we were serving the middle class and the lower middle class family whose major investment and happiness lie in the that their children studied in a good English medium school. This slowly build in us that we are building students whose sole aim was to educate and equip themselves for better tomorrow this in turn would uplift the family as whole. This enabled us to define our slot and mission that we must only part with quality need based and character building education that taught them how to think and not what to think.

Till the year 1968 the response that came forth built our confidence gradually. However those were also the years when government discouraged the growth of English medium schools through implementation of various contradictory policies and it seem at that time the future of English medium was bleak.

Our feelings were truly reflected in a poem by Longfellow.

*Not Enjoyment and sorrow,  
Is our destined end or way,  
But to act that each to morrow,  
Find us further than today.*

Amidst this pessimistic years we still moved ahead and each year owing to good response from parents and students we felt the need of



expanding. Eventually after reaching std VII the need of identifying a new location became all the more intense and in 1971 we hired a building near Maninagar (East) station. The Landlord constructed the first floor according to our need and we were able to accommodate 10 classes in the new building.

During the same time it seemed it was a quadrant jump time for Hebron as we still felt the space constraint and growing need of students and parents we decided to buy the adjoining buildings. The two buildings were then connected and we had ample space and most of all the relief that the Hebron students may not have to search for another school to complete their 12th STD as they could complete their studies till the board exams.

During the same time the government policy changed form SSCE to 10+2+3 pattern and we had to wait and watch till this policy was established and found working. It was a fluid situation and government was in process of elimination and was facing the problem of employing the professors and lecturers who were laid off. This laid off professors and lecturers were had to be absorbed in the 11th and 12th std of the schools and it was difficult time for us to absorb them in our culture and plans for progress as they came with different mindset and environment.

*The art of progress is to preserve order amidst the change*

*And preserve change amidst the order.*

Hebron continued to grow and produce great results. We are proud to say that past 15 years we have achieved 100% board result in S.S.C. and 90 to 100% I H.S.C. since 1983.

Today Hebron is proud of students and

staff who contributed their time and talent in building Hebron. Our philosophy to impart quality education and build character is reinforced every day by student receiving this philosophy and the teaching staff inculcating in them this philosophy.

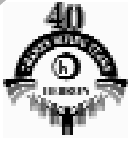

“B” stands for Brain, Royal divine for divine intellegency.

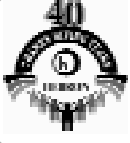
“R” stands for Retionalims royal intelegency for religious work.

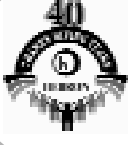
આશીર્વાદિત શૈક્ષણિક વિકાસયાત્રા

Blessings and Congratulations on this 40th anniversary and many more successes in the future.

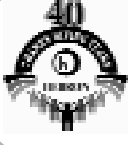

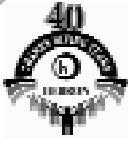

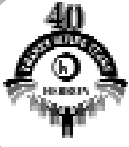
